Temporary Traffic Delay on U.S. 98 near Port Panama City

Chipley— Drivers traveling eastbound on U.S. 98 just east of the Hathaway Bridge in Panama City, will encounter temporary delays Thursday, Jan. 5 as workers remove an overhead sign. Law enforcement will be on site to direct traffic. Lane closures will remain in effect from 10:30 p.m. to 6 a.m.

This work is associated with the \$67.9 million 23rd Street Flyover project. All planned construction activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Motorists are reminded to pay attention to the speed limit when traveling through the construction area, to watch for construction equipment entering and leaving the roadway, and to use caution when driving through the work zone.
