Routine Bridge Inspection on Interstate 10 Shoal River Bridge

Chipley, FL – There will be east and westbound lane restrictions on Interstate 10 over the Shoal River, 2.4 miles east of State Road 85, in Okaloosa County Tuesday, June 23. Lane closures will be in effect from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. as crews perform a routine inspection.

Routine inspections are one tool the department uses to provide a safe transportation system, an example of the dedication to making travel in Florida safer and more efficient.

All activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or re-scheduled in the event of inclement weather. Motorists are reminded to travel with care through the work zone and to watch for construction equipment and workers entering and exiting the roadway.

Routine Maintenance Planned on State Roads in Escambia County

Chipley, FL – The following is an update on Florida Department of Transportation maintenance activities scheduled on state roads in Escambia County for the week of June 22, 2015.

- **I-10-** There will be a mobile operation in the westbound lanes at Eleven Mile Creek Bridge Monday, June 22 from 8 p.m. to 10 p.m. as crew perform routine bridge maintenance.
- **I-10-** There will be eastbound lane restrictions at Eleven Mile Creek Bridge from 10 p.m. Monday June 22, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, June 23 and from 8 p.m. Tuesday, June 23 to 5 a.m. Wednesday, June 24.
- **I-110 Overpass-** There will southbound lane closures at the I-110/I-10 interchange from 8 p.m. Wednesday, June 24 to 5 a.m. Thursday, June 25 as crews perform routine bridge maintenance.

Drivers are reminded to use caution, especially at night, when traveling through the work zone. Planned activities are weather dependent and may be rescheduled in the event of inclement weather.

State Road 85 Bridge Rehabilitation over Cinco and Garnier's Bayous

Chipley, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation will begin bridge rehabilitation work the week of Monday, June 22 on State Road (S.R) 85 over Cinco and Garnier's Bayous in Okaloosa County.

Motorists traveling S.R. 85 will not encounter traffic delays and the channel under the structures will remain open, however, navigational traffic is reminded there will be construction equipment and crews present in the waterway. Signs will be posted to alert marine traffic.

The \$4.5 million project is anticipated to be complete spring 2016.
