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FDOT to Hold Meeting on U.S. 98/Navarre Parkway Pedestrian Overpass

Chipley, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public information meeting Tuesday, June 30, from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. CDT at the Best Western Navarre Waterfront, 8697 Navarre Parkway, Navarre. The meeting is being held to allow participants an opportunity to view and provide comments on a proposed pedestrian overpass in the vicinity of Presidio Street on the north side of State Road 30 (U.S. 98) and the Navarre Park/Visitors Center on the south side of U.S. 98 in Santa Rosa County.

The intent of this project is to construct an attractive, user-friendly, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible pedestrian overpass that provides safe passage from the north side of U.S. 98 to the south side of U.S. 98. Right-of-way will be required for this project.

There will not be a formal presentation, however, FDOT representatives will be available to explain proposed improvements, answer questions, and receive comments. Maps, drawings, and other project information will be on display.

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Nighttime Lane Closures Rescheduled for U.S. 331 on the Clyde B. Wells Bridge

Chipley, FL – Drivers will encounter alternating lane closures on U.S. 331 across the Clyde B. Wells Bridge in Walton County from 10 p.m. Monday, June 29 to 6 a.m. Tuesday, June 30 as crews place concrete for the footings of the new bridge. Flagmen will be on site to safely direct traffic through the work zone.

Large concrete pump trucks will be present on the bridge so drivers are encouraged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone. All planned construction activities are weather dependent and may be re-scheduled in the event of inclement weather.
