FDOT to host Quincy Bypass Northern Loop Corridor Workshop

Chipley – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a corridor workshop concerning the Quincy Bypass northern loop connecting State Road (S.R.) 12 and County Road (C.R.) 268 (Solomon Dairy Road). The meeting will be held Thursday, July 30 from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. EDT at the National Guard Armory Drill Hall, 2049 Pat Thomas Parkway, Quincy.

The meeting is being held to provide the FDOT an opportunity to present corridor findings and to obtain input regarding other potential corridors from local governments, affected property owners and other members of the public. The meeting will begin as an open house at 5:30 p.m. followed by a formal presentation at 6 p.m.

Maps, project location boards, and other project information will be on display. FDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive input.

Nighttime Lane Closures Planned for I-10 in Escambia County

Chipley, FL – Drivers on Interstate 10 (I-10) westbound in Escambia County will encounter alternating lane closures near the Scenic Highway overpass beginning Monday, July 20. Lane closures will remain in effect from 8 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. for approximately three weeks as crews demolish the old Scenic Highway overpass.

In addition, the on-ramp from Scenic Highway to I-10 westbound will be intermittently closed during this time. Traffic will be detoured to Davis Highway for access to westbound I-10.

Temporary Delays on Area Roads

Chipley– A Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) geotechnical team will perform pavement tests Wednesday, July 15 from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. on two corridors. The slow moving operation will produce temporary delays on State Road (S.R.) 391 (Airport Road) between Jenks and S.R. 390 and on S.R. 368A (Collegiate Drive) from Moody Avenue to 23rd Street.

Maintenance crews will clean storm drainage structures on S.R. 30 (Business 98) from 6th Street to Florida Avenue, Wednesday, July 15. Drivers can expect temporary lane closures from 8 p.m. to midnight.

All activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Motorist are reminded to travel with care through the work zone.

West Sunset Avenue Bridge Replacement over Bayou Grande

Chipley, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation will begin construction activities on replacing the bridge located on County Road 292A (West Sunset Avenue) over Bayou Grande in Escambia County the week of July 20.

The \$5.4 million project will replace the existing bridge with a two-lane structure, add bike lanes and five-foot sidewalks.

During construction West Sunset Avenue will be closed to through traffic. Motorists will utilize State Road (S.R.) 295 (Navy Boulevard) and S.R. 292 (Gulf Beach Highway). A temporary signal will be placed at West Sunset Avenue and Gulf Beach Highway. Chattman Street and Syrcle Drive will also be accessible to West Sunset Avenue during construction. The project will take a little over one year to complete.

Work Planned on State Roads in Escambia County

Chipley, FL – Drivers traveling eastbound on State Road 750 (Airport Boulevard) in Escambia County will encounter minor delays east of Davis Highway Monday, July 20 and Tuesday, July 21. Lane closures will be in effect 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. for turn lane construction.
