Chipley, FL –Alternating lane closures will occur on U.S. 90 1.3 miles east of the Washington County line from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. Friday, July 24 as crews replace expansion joints on the bridge located over Cypress Slough.

All activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or re-scheduled in the event of inclement weather. Motorists are reminded to travel with care through the work zone and to watch for construction equipment and workers entering and exiting the roadway.

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Chase Street Overpass Bridge Temporary Closure

Chipley, FL – The overpass bridge on U.S. 98 (Chase Street) over Alcaniz Street in Pensacola will be closed to traffic from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Thursday, July 23 and Monday July 27 as crews perform bridge joint work. Motorists can utilize Tarragona Street, Garden Street and Alcaniz Street.

Motorists are reminded to use caution when traveling through the work zone. Planned activities are weather dependent and may be re-scheduled in the event of inclement weather.

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Lane closures on U.S. 98 in Wakulla County

Chipley– Motorists can expect alternating lane closures on State Road (S.R.) 30 (U.S. 98 / U.S. 319) from Boykin Road to S.R. 369 in Wakulla County on Wednesday, July 22. Florida Department of Transportation geotechnical survey crews will perform pavement coring and survey work from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

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Routine Maintenance on Mid-Bay Bridge

Chipley, FL – Drivers traveling on State Road 293 (Mid-Bay Bridge) in Okaloosa County will encounter alternating lane closures from 9 p.m. Wednesday, July 22 to 2 a.m. Thursday, July 23 as crews perform routine maintenance work. Traffic flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

Motorists are reminded to use caution when traveling, especially at night, in a work zone. Planned activities are weather dependent and may be re-scheduled in the event of inclement weather.

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Traffic Shift Planned for Eastbound U.S. 98 Traffic Over Cody Avenue

Chipley, FL – U.S. 98 eastbound traffic, near Hurlburt Field in Okaloosa County will be shifted to the newly constructed elevated travel lanes over Cody Avenue the morning of Saturday, July 25. Drivers destined for the Hurlburt Field main gate and soundside area will continue using the current alignment by exiting U.S. 98 to the right as they approach Cody Avenue.
