Routine U.S. 90 Bridge Inspection in Holmes County

Chipley, FL – Eastbound U.S. 90 drivers will encounter lane restrictions over Holmes Creek three miles west of State Road 277 in Holmes County Tuesday, Sept. 27. Lane closures will be in effect from 9 a.m. to noon as crews perform a routine inspection.

Routine inspections are one tool the department uses to provide a safe transportation system, an example of the dedication to making travel in Florida safer and more efficient.

All activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or re-scheduled in the event of inclement weather. Motorists are reminded to travel with care through the work zone and to watch for construction equipment and workers entering and exiting the roadway.
