Lane Closure on 23rd Street near Collegiate Drive

Chipley, FL – Drivers traveling 23rd Street (State Road 368) west of Posten Bayou Bridge to north of Collegiate Drive in Bay County will encounter lane restrictions from 10:30 p.m. through 6 a.m. Wednesday, Dec. 7 and Thursday, Dec. 8. The outside westbound lane will be closed to allow Dynamic Message Sign (DMS) foundation placement. Traffic signs and arrow boards will be on site to direct traffic.

This work is associated with the \$67.9 million 23rd Street Flyover project. All planned construction activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Motorists are reminded to pay attention to the speed limit when traveling through the construction area, to watch for construction equipment entering and leaving the roadway, and to use caution when driving through the work zone.
