## **Temporary Closure of Ramsey Road and U.S. 331 Intersection**

---

*Chipley, FL* – Ramsey Road at U.S. 331 will be closed for approximately one month beginning Monday, November 2 as crews make improvements to the intersection. Drivers seeking access to Ramsey Road will utilize Old Jolly Bay Road near State Road 20. Detour signs and variable message boards will be on site to direct traffic.

This realignment is part of a reconstruction project to multilane 4.6 miles of U.S. 331 from the north end of the Choctawhatchee Relief Bridge to south of S.R. 20. The project began in the fall of 2012 and is estimated to be completed winter 2016.

Construction activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or re-scheduled in the event of inclement weather. Motorists are reminded to pay attention to the speed limit when traveling through the construction area, to watch for construction equipment entering and leaving the roadway, and to use caution when driving through the work zone.
