Escambia and Santa Rosa County Traffic Alert

Chipley, FL – Drivers will encounter traffic disruptions on the following state roads in Escambia and Santa Rosa counties as crews perform construction and maintenance activities.

- **I-10 Six Lane, Santa Rosa County** - I-10 east and westbound between the Escambia Bay Bridge and State Road (S.R.) 281 (Avalon Boulevard) in Santa Rosa County. Alternating lane closures Sunday through Thursday beginning Nov. 1 and continuing through the end of 2015. Lane closures will be in effect from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. as crews perform construction activities.
- **Mobile Highway (S.R. 10A) between U.S. 90 and S.R. 727 (Fairfield Drive) in Escambia County** – Drivers can expect slow moving vehicles from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, Nov. 1 through Friday, Nov. 6 as crews perform striping operations.
- **U.S. 98 (Chase Street) between 9th Avenue and 12th Avenue in Escambia County.** Eastbound lane closure will be in effect from 8 p.m. to 4 a.m. Monday, Nov. 2 through Wednesday, November 4 as ECUA performs inspections.
- **Nine Mile Road from west of I-10 to Heritage Oaks Drive in Escambia County** - Eastbound and westbound lane closures from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Tuesday, Nov. 3 through Saturday, Nov. 8 as crews perform construction activities.
- **U.S. 98 (Garden Street) in Escambia County**- Lane closures will take place from 8 p.m. to 4 a.m. on U.S. 98 (Garden Street) on the following dates and locations as crews clean and video sanitary sewer lines:

- Wednesday, Nov. 4 and Thursday, Nov. Nov. 5
 - Garden Street median crossover at Tarragona Street.
 - Garden Street westbound outside lane at Tarragona Street.
 - Thursday, Nov. 5
 - Garden Street eastbound outside lane at Manresa Street.
- **I-110 Bridge Painting** - Drivers may encounter intermittent daytime restrictions on city streets under I-110 between Maxwell and Garden Streets as crews clean the bridges. The \$2.6 million rehabilitation project is anticipated to be complete summer 2016.

Drivers are reminded to use caution, especially at night, when traveling through a work zone.

All planned construction activities are weather dependent and may be re-scheduled in the event of inclement weather.

Chipley, FL – Drivers will encounter traffic disruptions on the following state roads in Okaloosa and Walton counties as crews perform construction activities.

- **Choctawhatchee Bay Bridge, Walton County** - U.S. 331 across the Choctawhatchee Bay Bridge (Clyde B. Wells Bridge) in Walton County. Intermittent lane closures from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday, Nov. 2 through Wednesday 4 as crews place concrete for the new bridge. In addition, drivers will encounter alternating lane closures on U.S. 331, between the relief bridge and Bay Grove Road from 7 p.m. Friday, Nov. 6 to 6 a.m. Saturday, Nov. 7 as crews to perform soil mixing operations.
- **State Road 20 at Armstrong Avenue in Okaloosa County** will encounter lane restrictions between 8 a.m. and 9 a.m. Tuesday, Nov. 3 as crews trim trees along the roadway.
- **State Road (S.R.) 123 from north of Toms Creek to north of Turkey Creek, Okaloosa County** - Traffic will be reduced to one lane from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Wednesday, Nov. 4 and Thursday, Nov. 5 as crews place beams for the new bridge. Traffic will only be allowed in one direction at a time. Flagmen and a pilot vehicle will be on site to safely guide motorists through the work zone.
- **State Road 293 (Spend Parkway) in Okaloosa County** will encounter intermittent and alternating lane restrictions from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Thursday, Nov 5 as crews perform routine maintenance activities as the toll gantry.

- **Choctawhatchee Bay Bridge in Walton County** - U.S. 331 across the Choctawhatchee Bay Bridge (Clyde B. Wells Bridge) in Walton County. Intermittent lane closures from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday, Nov. 2 through Wednesday, Nov. 4 as crews place concrete for the new bridge. In addition, drivers will encounter alternating lane closures on U.S. 331, between the relief bridge and Bay Grove Road from 7 p.m. Friday, Nov. 6 to 6 a.m. Saturday, Nov. 7 as crews to perform soil mixing operations.
- **State Road 83 over Juniper Creek in Walton County**- Alternating lane closure from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday, Nov. 2 as crews perform bridge joint repairs. Traffic flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.
- **I-10 from west of Boy Scout Road to east of U.S. 331 in Walton County**- East and westbound lane closures from 5 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday, Nov. 2 through Thursday, Nov. 5 as crews perform paving operations.
- **State Road 20 at Armstrong Avenue in Okaloosa County** - Lane restrictions between 8 a.m. and 9 a.m. Tuesday, Nov. 3 as crews trim trees along the roadway.
- **State Road (S.R.) 123 from north of Toms Creek to north of Turkey Creek in Okaloosa County** - Traffic will be reduced to one lane from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Wednesday, Nov. 4 and Thursday, Nov. 5 as crews place beams for the new bridge. Resurfacing Project Begins on Gulf Beach Highway

Chipley, FL – Resurfacing begins the week of Nov. 2 on State Road 292 (Gulf Beach Highway/Barrancas Avenue) from Merritt Street to South 3rd Street in Escambia County.

Additional improvements include roadway widening, signalization upgrades, drainage improvements and sidewalk construction. Drivers can expect intermittent and alternating day and nighttime lane closures. The project is estimated to be complete fall 2016.

All planned construction activities are weather dependent and may be rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers are reminded to pay attention to the posted speed limit when traveling through the construction area. They are also reminded to use caution while driving in a work zone.
