Corridor Analysis Public Meetings Scheduled for U.S. 331

Chipley, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host two similar corridor analysis public meetings concerning the U.S. 331 Project Development and Environment Study. The first meeting will be Tuesday, March 1 at the Paxton Agricultural Center, 22036 U.S. 331 North, Paxton. The second meeting will be Thursday, March 3 at the DeFuniak Springs Community Center Main Auditorium, 361 North 10th Street, DeFuniak Springs. Both meetings will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. CST.

The meetings will be held in an open-house format and will include an informational video. FDOT representatives will be available to discuss proposed improvements, answer questions, and receive comments. Maps, drawings, and other project information will be on display.

The study will evaluate the need for improvements along U.S. 331 from Coy Burgess Loop Road to the Alabama state line, a distance of approximately 25 miles. Proposed improvements under evaluation include widening, potential realignment, safety, traffic operations, intersection improvements, access management, bicycle lanes, and sidewalks.
