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Public Kick-Off Meeting Scheduled for U.S. 98

Chipley, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a public kick-off meeting for the U.S. 98 (Gregory Street) and State Road 196 (Bayfront Parkway) at 17th Avenue intersection Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study. The meeting will be Tuesday, March 29 from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. CDT at the New World Landing Banquet Room, 600 South Palafox Street, Pensacola.

The purpose of this study is to analyze and improve safety conditions as well as travel efficiencies along the corridor in conjunction with the new Pensacola Bay Bridge.

Maps, drawings, and other information will be on display. FDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments concerning this project; there will be no formal presentation.
