## Escambia and Santa Rosa County Traffic Alert

---

Chipley, FL – Drivers will encounter traffic disruptions on the following state roads in Escambia and Santa Rosa counties as crews perform construction and maintenance activities.

### Escambia County:

- **State Road (S.R) 196 (Bayfront Parkway)**- Temporary road closure between Tarragona Street and 14th Avenue from 6:30 a.m. to 10 a.m. Saturday, April 9 for the Navy Federal 5K Run/Walk. Traffic will utilize signed detour.
- **Interstate 10 (I-10) Widening**- Intermittent and alternating lane closures, between S.R. 291 (Davis Highway/Exit 13) and U.S. 90 (Scenic Highway/Exit 17), from 7 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. the week of Monday, April 11 as crews perform construction activities.
- **U.S. 98 (Garden Street)** - Eastbound outside lane closed at Spring Street from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday, April 11 and Tuesday, April 12 as crews perform underground utility work.
- **U.S. 98 (Garden Street)** - Westbound outside lane closed between 10th Avenue and 11th Avenue from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Wednesday, April 13 and Thursday, April 14 as crews perform underground utility work.
- **U.S. 98 (Garden Street)** - Westbound inside lane closed between Tarragona and Palafox Streets from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Thursday, April 14 and Monday, April 18 as crews perform underground utility work.
- **I-10/U.S. 29 Interchange Improvements**- The right lane of I-10 eastbound near U.S. 29 (Exits 10A and 10B) will be closed Tuesday, April 12 through Thursday, April 14 from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. as crews perform widening work.
- **S.R. 10 (Nine Mile Road)**- Intermittent westbound lane restrictions west of I-10 near Heritage Oaks Drive 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Wednesday, April 13 and Thursday, April 14 as crews perform construction activities.

## **Santa Rosa County:**

- **I-10 Widening-** Alternating lane closures on I-10, between the Escambia Bay Bridge and S.R. 281 (Avalon Boulevard/Exit 22), from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, April 10 through Thursday, April 14 as crews place barrier wall. In addition, alternating lane closures on Avalon Boulevard near the I-10 interchange during this time as crews perform bridge work.

All activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or re-scheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers are reminded to use caution, especially at night, when traveling in a work zone and to watch for construction workers and equipment entering and exiting the roadway.

## Okaloosa and Walton County Traffic Alert

---

**Chipley**– Drivers will encounter traffic restrictions on the following state roads in Okaloosa and Walton counties as crews perform construction activities.

### Okaloosa County:

- **Interstate 10 (I-10) Resurfacing**- Intermittent and alternating lane closures east and westbound between the Santa Rosa County line and east of the County Road (C.R.) 189 (Holt Exit) from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, April 10 through Thursday April 14. Drivers are reminded the speed limit will be reduced to 60 MPH in the active work zone.
- **U.S. 90 Resurfacing**- Eastbound and westbound lane closures from west of Summertime Drive to Old River Road from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday, April 11 through Saturday, April 16.
- **U.S. 90 Resurfacing**- Intermittent lane closures from west of Shoals River Bridge to the Walton County line from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday, April 11 through Saturday, April 16.

### Walton County:

- **U.S. 98**- Intermittent and alternating lane closures from Mack Bayou Road to C.R. 30A West from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday, April 11 and Tuesday, April 12 as crews perform roadway testing.
- **I-10 Resurfacing**- Intermittent east and westbound lane closures from west of Boy Scout Road to east of U.S. 331 from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday, April 11 through Thursday, April 14.

All activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Motorists are reminded to use caution, especially at night, when traveling in a work zone and to watch for construction workers and equipment entering and exiting the roadway.

## Public Meeting on Airport Boulevard Improvements

---

*Chipley, FL* – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public information meeting concerning proposed improvements to State Road (S.R.) 750 (Airport Boulevard). The meeting will be Tuesday, April 12 from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. CDT at the Hilton Garden Inn, San Carlos Banquet Room, 1144 Airport Boulevard, Pensacola.

The intent of this project is to resurface just over one mile of S.R. 750 (Airport Boulevard) from S.R. 291 (Davis Highway) to S.R. 289 (9th Avenue). Sidewalk construction and safety upgrades are included in the proposed improvements. There will be no formal presentation; however, FDOT representatives will be available to discuss proposed improvements, answer questions, and receive comments.

Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, disability, or family status.
