Nighttime Lane Restrictions Scheduled for State Road 85

Chipley, FL – Motorists traveling State Road (S.R.) 85 will encounter lane restrictions near the intersection of S.R. 123, from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Wednesday, May 4 through Saturday, May 7 as crews perform construction activities.

Construction activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers are reminded to use caution and watch for construction workers and equipment entering and exiting the roadway.

Nighttime Lane Closures Planned for U.S. 90 in Milton

Chipley, FL – Drivers will encounter alternating lane closures on U.S. 90 on the Marquis Bayou Bridge in Milton from 9 p.m. Thursday, May 5 to 6 a.m. Friday, May 6 as crews perform bridge work. Traffic flaggers will be on site to safely direct drivers through the work zone.

All planned construction activities are weather dependent and may be rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers are encouraged to obey the posted speed limit, be mindful of construction equipment entering and exiting the roadway, and refrain from texting while driving.
