CLOSED NIGHTLY MAY 31 — JUNE 2**

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

The I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street will undergo a full closure, nightly, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday, May 31 through Thursday, June 2 for construction activities. Traffic will be detoured via Hillsboro Boulevard and Military Trail.

This 1.5-mile project began construction May 2015 and is expected to be completed in summer 2017, weather permitting. Work is being performed by Community Asphalt Corp., with Cardno administering the construction contract for the Florida Department of Transportation.

On Thursday, June 2, 2016, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an informational Open House for the I-95 bridge deck replacement project over Gatlin Boulevard and Midway Road.

The Open House will be held from 4 PM until 6 PM at the St. Lucie County Fire District Administration Complex, 5160 NW Milner Drive, Port St. Lucie, FL 34983. Project personnel will be on hand to discuss the scope of work, construction schedule, and address questions and comments one-on-one. No formal presentation will be made.

This project is expected to begin June 6, 2016, and is anticipated to be completed by fall 2017, weather permitting. The cost for construction is \$8.16 million. Work will be performed by Morrison-Cobalt JV, with FDOT and Johnson, Mirmiran & Thompson, Inc. overseeing the project.

Scope of Work:

- Replacing the bridge decks on I-95 over Gatlin Boulevard and CR-712/ Midway Road
- Milling and resurfacing approaches to bridge decks
- Re-stripping approaches to bridge decks

Maintenance of Traffic:

During certain phases of the bridge deck removal and replacement, I-95 will be reduced from three lanes to two lanes in each direction at the Gatlin Boulevard & Midway Road overpasses.

Nighttime lane closures on Gatlin Boulevard will occur between the hours of 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. Daytime & nighttime lane closures will occur on Midway Road without any time restrictions. When work is occurring on the I-95 bridge decks over travel lanes, traffic will be shifted to utilize eastbound or westbound travel lanes, maintaining two-way traffic at all times.
