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

The I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street will undergo a full closure, nightly, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday, July 31 through Thursday, Aug. 4 for construction activities. Traffic will be detoured via Hillsboro Boulevard and Military Trail.

This 1.5-mile project began construction May 2015 and is expected to be completed in summer 2017, weather permitting. Work is being performed by Community Asphalt Corp., with Cardno administering the construction contract for the Florida Department of Transportation.

On Tuesday, Aug. 9, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an informational Open House for the I-95 Express Phase 3A-1 & 3A-2 projects from Broward Boulevard to south of SW 10th Street in Broward County. The meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the FDOT District 4 Auditorium, located at 3400 W. Commercial Boulevard in Ft. Lauderdale.

Project personnel will be on hand to discuss the scope of work, construction schedule, and address questions and comments one-on-one. No formal presentation will be made.

This \$303 million, 16.5-mile combined project will begin construction on Sunday, Aug. 14, and is expected to be completed in winter 2020, weather permitting. Work is being performed by The de Moya Group, Inc. and Prince Contracting, with New Millennium and HNTB administering the construction contracts for FDOT.

Scope of Work

- Extend the existing express lanes north from just south of Broward Boulevard to just south of SW 10th Street.
- Add a lane and convert the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to create two express lanes in each direction.
- Install ramp signalization from Hallandale Beach Boulevard to Commercial Boulevard.
- Install ramp signalization from Cypress Creek Road to Sample Road.
- Construct noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 Southbound between Broward Boulevard and NW 6th Street, and along I-95 Northbound between Powerline Road and Commercial Boulevard.
- Construct noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 Northbound between Atlantic Boulevard and Sample Road, and along I-95 Southbound north of Sample Road.
- Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment and widening of bridges .



Indrio Road Widening Project

INDRIO ROAD WESTBOUND TRAFFIC SHIFT

Westbound traffic on Indrio Road from Spanish Lakes Boulevard to east of Koblegard Road is shifted to the south, utilizing the existing eastbound lane. Both eastbound and westbound traffic are reduced to one lane in each direction. This shift is taking place to facilitate the roadway reconstruction on the north side of Indrio Road.

As a part of this westbound traffic shift, the left-turn lane out of Spanish Lakes Fairways is closed and all motorists leaving the community **MUST** make a right turn onto Indrio Road. Motorists wanting to head eastbound on Indrio Road should head west on Indrio Road and make a U-turn at the opening after the I-95 overpass.

This work is part of the \$23.95 million Indrio Road widening project from west of the I-95 interchange to east of Emerson Avenue (State Road 607). Work on this project includes: reconstructing the existing two-lane Indrio Road to a four-lane, divided highway with a raised median; constructing a 6-foot sidewalk along the south side and a 12-foot-wide multi-purpose trail along the north side of Indrio Road; realigning Spanish Lakes Boulevard to connect with Koblegard Road; reconstructing Koblegard Road from Indrio Road north approximately .5 mile; and installing new highway lighting, signage and signalization. This project is anticipated to be completed in spring 2019.
