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SOUTH FLORIDA AND TREASURE COAST WEEKLY LANE CLOSURES AND WORK ZONE ADVISORY

FORT LAUDERDALE — [Florida's Turnpike](http://www.floridasturnpike.com) announces updated lane closures and work zones due to construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie counties, for the week beginning Sunday, Feb. 21. All paving-related lane closures depend on weather conditions; rain and/or cold weather may delay or cancel paving operations.

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES – SW 216th ST. TO EUREKA DR.

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Quail Roost Drive/SW 186th Street will close for the entire weekend** beginning at 11 p.m. Friday, Feb. 19, and reopening by 5 a.m. Monday, Feb. 22.
 - **DETOUR** – Traffic will be detoured during this closure. Northbound motorists should take SW 211th Street to the Frontage Road/SW 107th Avenue and travel north to US 1. Then travel northeast to Marlin Road, then north to Quail Roost Drive/SW 186th Street. Please follow posted detour signs.
- **Florida's Turnpike** – One lane in each direction may be closed nightly at various locations between Southwest 216th Street and Eureka Drive/Southwest 184th Street from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, Feb. 21 and Thursday, Feb. 25.
- **Eureka Drive** – One lane in each direction at the Turnpike interchange may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, Feb. 21 and Thursday, Feb. 25.
- **Quail Roost Drive** – Both westbound lanes plus one eastbound lane may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Wednesday, Feb. 24; both eastbound lanes plus one westbound lane may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Thursday, Feb. 25 and Friday, Feb. 26.

- DETOUR Westbound – Travel north on SW 107th Avenue to Eureka Drive/SW 184th Street, then west to the frontage road, then south to Quail Roost Drive. Please follow posted detour signs.
- DETOUR Eastbound – Travel north on SW 117th Avenue to Eureka Drive/SW 184th Street, then east to 107th Avenue, then south to Quail Roost Drive. Please follow posted detour signs.

SPECIAL NOTE: For the weekend of Feb. 26-29, all eastbound and westbound lanes on Quail Roost Drive in the vicinity of the Turnpike interchange are scheduled to close. The lanes will close at 10 p.m., Friday, Feb. 26, and reopen at 5 a.m., Monday, Feb. 29.

- **US 1** – One lane in each direction may be closed nightly at the Turnpike interchange from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, Feb. 21 and Thursday, Feb. 25.
- **Caribbean Boulevard** – One lane in each direction may be closed nightly at the Turnpike interchange from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, Feb. 21 and Thursday, Feb. 25; and daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.
- **Southwest 211th Street/Cutler Ridge Drive** – One lane in each direction may be closed nightly at the Turnpike interchange from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, Feb. 21 and Thursday, Feb. 25; and daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from four lanes to six, eight and 10 lanes. Express lanes, similar to those on I-95, will be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas on the east side of the Turnpike. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in August 2013 and is scheduled for completion in the fall of 2016. Approximate cost: \$41.6 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES – EUREKA DRIVE TO KILLIAN PARKWAY

- **Florida's Turnpike** – One lane in each direction between Southwest 184th Street/Eureka Drive and Southwest 104th Street/Killian Parkway may be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, Feb. 21 and Thursday, Feb. 25.
- **Southbound Turnpike exit to Southwest 120th Street** – One ramp lane will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, Feb. 21 and Thursday, Feb. 25. One ramp lane will remain open.
- **Southwest 117th Avenue** – One lane in either direction at the Turnpike interchange may be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.
 - During bridge construction the left-turn lane from southbound 117th Avenue to the southbound Turnpike entrance ramp will be closed and traffic will be detoured via Southwest 152nd Street. Please follow posted detour signs.
- **Southwest 152nd Street** – One lane in either direction at the Turnpike interchange may be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26; one lane in either direction may be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Wednesday, Feb. 24 and Friday, Feb. 26.
- **Southwest 168th Street** – One lane between SW 112th Avenue and SW 117th Avenue will be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, Feb. 21 and Thursday, Feb. 25.

- Drivers may use SW 184th Street and SW 152nd Street as alternate routes.
- **Northbound and southbound Turnpike frontage road** – One lane in either direction between Southwest 152nd Street and Southwest 117th Avenue may be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. between Sunday, Feb. 21 and Thursday, Feb. 25.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened to eight and 12 lanes. Express lanes, similar to those on I-95, will be constructed. The Turnpike/S.R. 874 interchange will be realigned. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, landscaping, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in March 2014 and is scheduled for completion in early 2017. Approximate cost: \$145.3 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES – KILLIAN PARKWAY TO SUNSET DRIVE

- **No lane closures scheduled.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes, similar to those on I-95, will be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The Turnpike on-ramps at Kendall Drive will be reconfigured. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in May 2015 and will continue through early 2018. Approximate cost: \$73.9 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES – SUNSET DRIVE TO BIRD ROAD

- **Florida's Turnpike** – Up to two lanes northbound and southbound at various locations between Sunset Drive/SW 72nd Street and Bird Road/SW 40th Street may be closed nightly from 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, Feb. 21 and Thursday, Feb. 25.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes, similar to those on I-95, will be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The project entails major improvements at the Bird Road interchange. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements. Construction began in July 2015 and will continue through early 2018. Approximate cost: \$54.4 million.

TURNPIKE TOLL EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE – VARIOUS LOCATIONS

- **SW 40th Street Toll Plaza** – One ramp lane southbound from Florida's Turnpike to SW 40th Street will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Tuesday, Feb. 23. The ramp will remain open to traffic.
- **Homestead Toll Plaza** – One lane northbound will be closed overnight from 10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Wednesday, Feb. 24. The toll plaza will remain open to traffic.

- **Okeechobee Road/US 27 Toll Plaza** – One ramp lane southbound from Okeechobee Road/US 27 to Florida’s Turnpike will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Thursday, Feb. 25; one ramp lane northbound from Florida’s Turnpike to Okeechobee Road/US 27 will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Thursday, Feb. 25. The ramps will remain open to traffic.

ALLAPATTAH ROAD/SW 112TH AVENUE RESURFACING

- **Southbound Turnpike exit to southbound Allapattah Road/Southwest 112th Avenue** – Closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 2 a.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Sunday, Feb. 28.
 - DETOUR – Drivers who wish to use Exit 9A can use Exit 9B; continue north on Southwest 112th Avenue; turn east onto Southwest 248th Street; turn south onto Southwest 107th Avenue; turn west onto Southwest 256th Street; turn south on Southwest 112th Avenue. Please follow posted detour signs.
- **Southbound Turnpike exit to northbound Allapattah Road/Southwest 112th Avenue** – Closed nightly from 2 a.m. to 5:30 a.m., between Tuesday, Feb. 23 and Sunday, Feb. 28.
 - DETOUR – Drivers who wish to use Exit 9B can use Exit 9A, continue south on Southwest 112th Avenue and then make a U-turn. Please follow posted detour signs.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District 6 Office is resurfacing Southwest 112th Avenue from the Turnpike interchange to Southwest 248th Street. For project information contact Sergies Duarte at Sergies.Duarte@dot.state.fl.us.

BROWARD COUNTY

TURNPIKE ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION – HOLLYWOOD BOULEVARD & GRIFFIN ROAD

- **No lane closures scheduled.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: All-electronic tolling gantries will be constructed to replace the ramp toll plazas at the Turnpike’s Hollywood/Pines Boulevard and Griffin Road interchanges. All-electronic tolling was implemented on Aug. 29, 2015. One existing toll lane will be converted to a SunPass-only lane at the Northwest 199th Street/Dolphin Center toll plaza in Miami-Dade. The project also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing at the Northwest 199th Street/Dolphin Center and County Line Road interchange ramps. Approximate cost: \$10.6 million.

75-EXPRESS CONSTRUCTION

- **All northbound lanes on the Sawgrass Expressway at the I-595 interchange will close nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Wednesday, Feb. 24 and Thursday, Feb. 25.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured to the entrance ramp to eastbound I-595, then exit at Flamingo Road, make a U-turn, then travel westbound on SR 84 to re-enter westbound I-595 and take the entrance ramp to northbound Sawgrass Expressway. Please follow posted detour signs.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Florida Department of Transportation is implementing express lanes along 28 miles of the I-75 and State Road (SR) 826 (Palmetto Expressway) corridors, from just south of the SR 836 (Dolphin Expressway), in Miami-Dade County, to I-595 in Broward County. TURNPIKE & SUNRISE BOULEVARD INTERCHANGE MODIFICATIONS

Florida's Turnpike

- **Two lanes northbound and southbound will be closed overnight** from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Monday, Feb. 22.
- **One lane northbound and southbound may be closed nightly** from 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., between Sunday, Feb. 21 and Thursday, Feb. 25. A second lane in each direction may close at 9 p.m.
- **Outside shoulders northbound and southbound may be closed daily** from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.

Sunrise Boulevard

- **One lane eastbound and westbound may be closed daily** from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.
- **One lane eastbound and westbound may be closed nightly** from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., between Sunday, Feb. 21 and Thursday, Feb. 25. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike is modifying and improving the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard, and implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the interchange. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$50 million and work will continue through late 2019.

ELECTRONIC SIGN INSTALLATIONS

When approaching Florida's Turnpike from:

- **Sunrise Boulevard west of Northwest 56th Avenue** – two eastbound lanes will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.
- **Sunrise Boulevard west of Northwest 43rd Avenue** – one westbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.
- **Commercial Boulevard east of Northwest 47th Terrace** – one westbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.
- **Commercial Boulevard east of North Sabal Palm Boulevard** – one eastbound lane closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.
- **Sample Road east of Coral Tree Circle** – one eastbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.

- **Sample Road west of Powerline Road** – one westbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida’s Turnpike is installing dynamic message signs in Broward and Palm Beach counties to keep motorists better informed about driving conditions before entering the Turnpike. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$1.7 million and be complete by May.

PALM BEACH COUNTY

ELECTRONIC SIGN INSTALLATIONS

When approaching Florida’s Turnpike from:

- **Atlantic Avenue east of Stone Quarry Road** – one westbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.
- **Atlantic Avenue east of Lyons Road** – one eastbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.

Florida’s Turnpike

- **The southbound shoulders near the Atlantic Avenue interchange may be closed daily** from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, Feb. 22 and Friday, Feb. 26.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida’s Turnpike is installing dynamic message signs in Broward and Palm Beach counties to keep motorists better informed about driving conditions before entering the Turnpike. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$1.7 million and be complete by May.

ST. LUCIE COUNTY

PORT ST. LUCIE/FORT PIERCE SERVICE PLAZA RECONSTRUCTION

- The Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza on Florida’s Turnpike is under reconstruction. A new convenience store with limited food service is now open, along with a new fuel station.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The \$21 million project to renovate and reconstruct the Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza includes a 40,000-square-foot restaurant building; 3,500-square-foot convenience store and fueling pumps; and expanded truck parking.

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
