FORT LAUDERDALE — [Florida's Turnpike](#) announces updated lane closures and work zones due to construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie counties, for the week beginning Sunday, March 6. All paving-related lane closures depend on weather conditions; rain and/or cold weather may delay or cancel paving operations.

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES – SW 216th ST. TO EUREKA DR.

- **Quail Roost Drive** – All eastbound lanes on Quail Roost Drive at the Turnpike interchange will be closed all weekend. **The lanes will close at 10 p.m., Friday, March 4, and reopen at 5 a.m., Monday, March 7.**
 - DETOUR Eastbound – Travel north on SW 117th Avenue to Eureka Drive/SW 184th Street, then east to 107th Avenue, then south to Quail Roost Drive. Please follow posted detour signs.Also, one of two westbound lanes on Quail Roost Drive is closed for several weeks. Westbound Quail Roost Drive remains open to traffic.
- **Florida's Turnpike** – One lane in each direction may be closed nightly at various locations between Southwest 216th Street and Eureka Drive/Southwest 184th Street from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10.
- **US 1** – One lane or two lanes in each direction may be closed nightly at the Turnpike interchange from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10.
- **Caribbean Boulevard** – One lane in each direction may be closed nightly at the Turnpike interchange from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10; and daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.
- **Southwest 211th Street/Cutler Ridge Drive** – One lane in each direction may be closed nightly at the Turnpike interchange from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10; and daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.

- **Southwest 216th Street** – One lane westbound may be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from four lanes to six, eight and 10 lanes. Express lanes, similar to those on I-95, will be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas on the east side of the Turnpike. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in August 2013 and is scheduled for completion in the fall of 2016. Approximate cost: \$41.6 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES – EUREKA DRIVE TO KILLIAN PARKWAY

- **Southwest 168th Street** – All eastbound and westbound lanes at the Turnpike interchange will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Tuesday, March 8. (If necessary, the overnight closure will be extended through Wednesday, March 9.)
 - DETOUR – Drivers should use SW 184th Street or SW 152nd Street as alternate routes. Please follow posted detour signs.
- **Southwest 117th Avenue** – All northbound lanes and one southbound lane at the Turnpike interchange will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, March 6 and Saturday, March 12.
 - DETOUR Northbound – Drivers will be detoured through Southwest 152nd Street. Please follow posted detour signs.

Also, one lane in either direction may be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. between Sunday, March 6 and Friday, March 11.

- **Florida's Turnpike** – One lane in each direction between Southwest 184th Street/Eureka Drive and Southwest 104th Street/Killian Parkway may be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10.
- **Southwest 152nd Street** – One eastbound OR westbound lane may be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.
- **Northbound and southbound Turnpike frontage road** – All southbound lanes between Southwest 152nd Street and Southwest 117th Avenue will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, March 6 and Friday, March 11; and one lane in either direction may be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. between Sunday, March 6 and Friday, March 11.
 - DETOUR Southbound – Drivers will be detoured through Southwest 152nd Street. Please follow posted detour signs.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened to eight and 12 lanes. Express lanes, similar to those on I-95, will be constructed. The Turnpike/S.R. 874 interchange will be realigned. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, landscaping, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in March 2014 and is scheduled for completion in early 2017. Approximate cost: \$145.3 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES – KILLIAN PARKWAY TO SUNSET DRIVE

- **No closures scheduled.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes, similar to those on I-95, will be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The Turnpike on-ramps at Kendall Drive will be reconfigured. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in May 2015 and will continue through early 2018. Approximate cost: \$73.9 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES – SUNSET DRIVE TO BIRD ROAD

- **Florida's Turnpike** – Up to two lanes northbound and southbound at various locations between Sunset Drive/SW 72nd Street and Bird Road/SW 40th Street may be closed nightly from 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes, similar to those on I-95, will be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The project entails major improvements at the Bird Road interchange. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements. Construction began in July 2015 and will continue through early 2018. Approximate cost: \$54.4 million.

TURNPIKE RESURFACING – NORTH OF OKEECHOBEE ROAD TO NW 106TH STREET

- **No closures scheduled.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A project to remove and replace existing pavement on the travel lanes and on selected entrance and exit ramps from one mile north of Okeechobee Road to NW 106th Street in Miami began in February 2016. It is anticipated that the project will cost approximately \$1.4 million and be completed in summer 2016.

TURNPIKE TOLL EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE – VARIOUS LOCATIONS

- **SW 40th Street Toll Plaza** – One lane on the northbound entrance ramp to Florida's Turnpike from SW 40th Street will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Tuesday, March 8. The toll plaza will remain open to traffic.
- **Miramar Toll Plaza** – One lane on the southbound entrance ramp to Florida's Turnpike from 27th Street will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Wednesday, March 9. The toll plaza will remain open to traffic.
- **NW 12th Street Toll Plaza** – One lane on the northbound entrance ramp to Florida's Turnpike from NW 12th Street OR one lane on the southbound entrance ramp from Florida's Turnpike to NW 12th Street will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Thursday, March 10. The toll plaza will remain open to traffic.

ALLAPATTAH ROAD/SW 112TH AVENUE RESURFACING

- **Southbound Turnpike exit to southbound Allapattah Road/Southwest 112th Avenue** – Closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 2 a.m., between Monday, March 7 and Sunday, March 13.
 - DETOUR – Drivers who wish to use Exit 9A can use Exit 9B; continue north on Southwest 112th Avenue; turn east onto Southwest 248th Street; turn south onto Southwest 107th Avenue; turn west onto Southwest 256th Street; turn south on Southwest 112th Avenue. Please follow posted detour signs.
- **Southbound Turnpike exit to northbound Allapattah Road/Southwest 112th Avenue** – Closed nightly from 2 a.m. to 5:30 a.m., between Tuesday, March 8 and Sunday, March 13.
 - DETOUR – Drivers who wish to use Exit 9B can use Exit 9A, continue south on Southwest 112th Avenue and then make a U-turn. Please follow posted detour signs.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District 6 Office is resurfacing Southwest 112th Avenue from the Turnpike interchange to Southwest 248th Street. For project information contact Sergies Duarte at Sergies.Duarte@dot.state.fl.us.

BROWARD COUNTY

TURNPIKE ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION – HOLLYWOOD BOULEVARD & GRIFFIN ROAD

- **Northbound and southbound Turnpike entrance ramps OR exit ramps at Hollywood Boulevard** – Closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10.
 - DETOUR to enter Turnpike – Drivers should take U.S. 441 north to Griffin Road or south to County Line Road and use the Turnpike entrance ramps at either interchange. Please follow posted detour signs.
 - DETOUR to exit Turnpike – Drivers should exit at either I-595 or Griffin Road and then take U.S. 441 south to Hollywood Boulevard. Please follow posted detour signs.
- **Northbound Turnpike entrance from Griffin Road** – Closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10.
 - DETOUR – Drivers should take US 441/SR 7 north to I-595 and then take the northbound ramp to Florida's Turnpike. Please follow posted detour signs. ***The northbound entrance ramps at Griffin Road and Hollywood Boulevard, will not be closed at the same time.***
- **Southbound Turnpike exit to Griffin Road** – Closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10.
 - DETOUR – Drivers should exit at I-595, take the exit to southbound US 441/SR 7 then travel south to Griffin Road. Please follow posted detour signs. ***The southbound exit ramps at Griffin Road and Hollywood Boulevard will not be closed at the same time.***
- **Southbound Turnpike exit to westbound Pines Boulevard** – Closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10.
 - DETOUR: Traffic should exit at Hollywood Boulevard. Please follow posted detour signs. ***The exit ramps to Pines Boulevard and Hollywood Boulevard will not be closed at the same time.***

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: All-electronic tolling gantries will be constructed to replace the ramp toll plazas at the Turnpike's Hollywood/Pines Boulevard and Griffin Road interchanges. All-electronic tolling was implemented on Aug. 29, 2015. One existing toll lane will be converted to a SunPass-only lane at the Northwest 199th Street/Dolphin Center toll plaza in Miami-Dade. The project also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing at the Northwest 199th Street/Dolphin Center and County Line Road interchange ramps. Approximate cost: \$10.6 million.

75-EXPRESS CONSTRUCTION

- **All northbound lanes on Florida's Turnpike at the I-75 interchange will close nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, March 6 and Monday, March 7.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured to the entrance ramp to northbound I-75, exit at Miramar Parkway East, continue east on Miramar Parkway to NW 57th Avenue/Red Road, then turn south on NW 57th Avenue/Red Road to re-enter northbound Florida's Turnpike. Please follow posted detour signs.
- **All southbound lanes on Florida's Turnpike at the I-75 interchange will close nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured to the exit ramp at Red Road, continue northbound on Red Road, turn westbound on Miramar Parkway to enter southbound I-75, then take the entrance ramp to re-enter southbound Florida's Turnpike. Please follow posted detour signs.
- **One lane of the ramp from northbound Florida's Turnpike to northbound I-75** will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10.
- **One lane of the ramp from southbound I-75 to southbound Florida's Turnpike** to will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10
- **Two lanes of northbound Florida's Turnpike, north and south of I-75** will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10.
- **Two lanes of southbound Florida's Turnpike, north and south of I-75** will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Florida Department of Transportation is implementing express lanes along 28 miles of the I-75 and State Road (SR) 826 (Palmetto Expressway) corridors, from just south of the SR 836 (Dolphin Expressway), in Miami-Dade County, to I-595 in Broward County. TURNPIKE & SUNRISE BOULEVARD INTERCHANGE MODIFICATIONS

Florida's Turnpike between Sunrise Boulevard and Broward Boulevard

- **Outside shoulders northbound and southbound may be closed daily** from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.

- **One lane northbound and southbound may be closed nightly** from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m.

Sunrise Boulevard between NW 47th Avenue and NW 56th Avenue

- **One lane eastbound and westbound may be closed daily** from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.
- **One lane eastbound and westbound may be closed nightly** from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., between Sunday, March 6 and Thursday, March 10. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike is modifying and improving the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard, and implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the interchange. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$50 million and work will continue through late 2019.

ELECTRONIC SIGN INSTALLATIONS

When approaching Florida's Turnpike from:

- **Sunrise Boulevard west of Northwest 56th Avenue** – Two eastbound lanes will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.
- **Sunrise Boulevard west of Northwest 43rd Avenue** – One westbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.
- **Commercial Boulevard east of Northwest 47th Terrace** – One westbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.
- **Commercial Boulevard east of North Sabal Palm Boulevard** – One eastbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.
- **Commercial Boulevard Bridge over the Turnpike** – One westbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.
- **Sample Road east of Coral Tree Circle** – One eastbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.
- **Sample Road west of Powerline Road** – One westbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike is installing dynamic message signs in Broward and Palm Beach counties to keep motorists better informed about driving conditions before entering the Turnpike. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$1.7 million and be complete by May.

TOLL EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE – SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY

- **Atlantic Boulevard Toll Plaza** – One lane on the northbound entrance ramp to the Sawgrass Expressway from Atlantic Boulevard will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Tuesday, March 8. The toll plaza will remain open to traffic.
- **Pat Salerno Drive Toll Plaza** – One lane on the northbound entrance ramp to the Sawgrass Expressway from Pat Salerno Drive will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Tuesday, March 8. The toll plaza will remain open to traffic.
- **University Drive Toll Plaza** – One lane on the southbound entrance ramp to the Sawgrass Expressway from University Drive OR one lane on the northbound exit ramp from the Sawgrass Expressway to University Drive will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Wednesday, March 9. The toll plaza will remain open to traffic.
- **Lyons Road Toll Plaza** – One lane on the southbound entrance ramp to the Sawgrass Expressway from Lyons Road will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Thursday, March 10. The toll plaza will remain open to traffic.
- **Sample Road Toll Plaza** – One lane on the northbound entrance ramp to the Sawgrass Expressway from Sample Road will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., on Thursday, March 10. The toll plaza will remain open to traffic.

ROADWAY MAINTENANCE – SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY

- **Lyons Road** – One northbound lane on the Sawgrass Expressway in the vicinity of the Lyons Road interchange will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, March 6 and Tuesday, March 8.
- **Florida's Turnpike** – One southbound lane on the Sawgrass Expressway in the vicinity of the Florida's Turnpike interchange will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, March 6 and Tuesday, March 8.

PALM BEACH COUNTY

ELECTRONIC SIGN INSTALLATIONS

When approaching Florida's Turnpike from:

- **Atlantic Avenue east of Stone Quarry Road** – One westbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.
- **Atlantic Avenue east of Lyons Road** – One eastbound lane will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.

Florida's Turnpike

- **The southbound shoulder on the bridge over Atlantic Avenue may be closed daily** from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., between Monday, March 7 and Friday, March 11.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike is installing dynamic message signs in Broward and Palm Beach counties to keep motorists better informed about driving conditions before entering the Turnpike. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$1.7 million and be complete by May.

ST. LUCIE COUNTY

PORT ST. LUCIE/FORT PIERCE SERVICE PLAZA RECONSTRUCTION

- The Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza on Florida's Turnpike is under reconstruction. A new convenience store with limited food service is now open, along with a new fuel station.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The \$21 million project to renovate and reconstruct the Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza includes a 40,000-square-foot restaurant building; 3,500-square-foot convenience store and fueling pumps; and expanded truck parking.

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
