## SUBTROPICAL STORM ALBERTO EMERGENCY ORDER (Pursuant to Executive Order No. 18-150)

I hereby find that the Department of Transportation's timely performance of disaster response functions related to the Subtropical Storm Alberto is hindered by the application of procedures imposed by statute, rule, or order.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority granted by Section 4 of Executive Order 18-150, I hereby suspend the effect of any statute, rule, or order, as needed to: (i) suspend the size and weight restrictions for divisible loads on any vehicles transporting emergency equipment, services, supplies, and agricultural commodities and citrus as recommended by the Commissioner of Agriculture, allowing the establishment of alternative size and weight restrictions for all such vehicles by permit; and (ii) waive by special permit the warning signal requirements in the Utility Accommodation Manual to accommodate public utility companies from other jurisdictions to render assistance in restoring vital services.

This order shall expire on the earlier of the expiration or rescission of Executive Order 18-150 or June 1, 2018, unless extended by me.
