



Laboratory Profile

What is a Laboratory Profile?

A Laboratory Profile in MAC represent the facility information as published on the Qualified Labs List. It is the record in MAC that identifies the company name by way of tying the Laboratory Profile to the Company Profile. It is used for laboratories in the Qualified Laboratory Program and for additional listings for approved labs under other programs managed by the SMO such as corrosion testing. It identifies the laboratory location and contact information which will be maintained by the Laboratory Profile Manager. Other fields related to the Laboratory Profile will be associated to the facility by the Materials Offices.

Who is the Laboratory Profile Manager?

The Laboratory Profile Manger is the person in the laboratory's company who has access to MAC and maintains the laboratory's profile in the system. By allowing companies to manage their own contact information, updates can be made in a timelier manner and do not rely on Department personnel to make the updates.

NOTE: A laboratory facility can have one or more Laboratory Profile Manager. A Laboratory Profile Manager can manage more than one profile.

What about the current Laboratory information in LIMS?

The current laboratory information from LIMS will be transferred to MAC including the test methods. Because MAC uses the Company Profile concept, the LIMS information will have to be associated to a MAC Company Profile. Laboratory Profile Managers will also have to be identified so they can gain access to the profile information. This will occur during the implementation process in a way that companies will have time to review the data and provide input for the data before MAC Production begins. We will notify companies when this process begins and how to gain access to the data for review.

What about new test methods?

The Laboratory Profile Manager will have the ability to request that a new test method be added to the profile.

What else can the Laboratory Profile Manager do?

The laboratory inspection and issuing of the Laboratory Qualification Performance Review (LQPR) will be processed in MAC. The Laboratory Profile Manager will have the ability to view the LQPR, and address any deficiencies, if there are any. The Laboratory Profile Manager will work with the FDOT Laboratory Coordinator to resolve Unsatisfactory LQPRs.
