*Production Facility Profile*

***What is a Production Facility Profile?***

A Production Facility Profile in MAC represent the facility information as published on the Production Facility Listing (currently known as the Producers with Accepted QC Programs). It is the record in MAC that identifies the facility company name by way of tying the Production Facility Profile to the Company Profile. It is used for mines, production plants and terminals. It identifies the facility location and contact information which will be maintained by the Production Facility Profile Manager. Other fields related to the Production Facility Profile will be associated to the facility by the Materials Offices.

***Who is the Production Facility Profile Manager?***

The Production Facility Profile Manager is a user that has authority to manage the location and contact information that is used to generate the Production Facility Listing. By allowing companies to manage their own contact information, updates can be made in a timelier manner and do not rely on Department personnel to make the updates.

**NOTE:** A production facility can have one or more Production Facility Profile Manager. A Production Facility Profile Manager can manage more than one profile.

***What about the current Production Facility information in LIMS?***

The current producer information from LIMS will be transferred to MAC. Because MAC uses the Company Profile concept, the LIMS information will have to be associated to a MAC Company Profile. Production Facility Profile Managers will also have to be identified so they can gain access to the profile information. This will occur during the implementation process in a way that companies will have time to review the data and provide input for the data before MAC Production begins. We will notify companies when this process begins and how to gain access to the data for review.

***What about Production Facility Profiles that have products associated to the facility?***

The current product information in LIMS will also be transferred and companies with facilities that have products (aggregate mines, aggregate terminals, cement plants, cement terminals, binder production facilities, ...) will have the ability to review that data before MAC goes into Production. Once in Production, Production Facility Managers will have the ability to request new products from the Production Facility profile.
