Workshop Objective: Learn about the 5310 Elderly and Persons with Disabilities Grant Programs administered by the Florida Department of Transportation. The workshop will cover how to complete grant applications for this program and touch upon Section 5316-Job Access Reverse Commute and Section 5317-New Freedom.

Purpose of Grant Program: The purpose of this grant program is to assist non-profit agencies and community transportation coordinators with small buses or vans to transport clients.

Eligible Costs: Capital costs associated with vehicles and this program does not cover operating expenses. A ten percent match is required for any applicants that receive an award. Last year there were 25 awards totaling a little over \$1.8 Million for; Citrus, Hernando, Hillsborough, Pasco and Pinellas County. Average awards range from \$25,000 to \$150,000.
