


Transportation Improvements – Florida at Work

District Four ARRA Status Report – August 24, 2010

ARRA Implementation Status in FDOT District Four

- 43 ARRA projects are being implemented in District Four including 24 local agency managed projects and 14 enhancement projects.
- 39 ARRA projects have been authorized.
- 38 ARRA projects have been advertised.
- 35 ARRA projects have been awarded.
- 33 ARRA projects have been issued the Construction Notice to Proceed.
- 22 ARRA projects are under construction. 8 projects have been completed.
- 2 bridges will be replaced using ARRA funds.
- 12 ARRA projects are located in Economically Distressed Areas.

ARRA Project Highlights

- On Aug. 16, the new Tequesta Dr. Bridge was opened to two-way traffic. Also now open is the sidewalk on the north side of the bridge for pedestrian and bicycle traffic. Construction continues on the south side of the bridge. The project is expected to be completed in September
- Selection process is underway for the design-build team for 95 Express Phase II.
- The City of Deerfield Beach anticipates completion of their Goolsby Blvd. Project by the end of August.
