
Air Quality

Emissions Trends for Highway Vehicles (Relative to 2002)




Transportation Alternatives/Enhancements

SUPPORTING MEASURE

Surveyed residents indicate a slight decreased perception of roadside attractiveness. Conversely, visitors indicate a high level of satisfaction with 92% agreeing that State Highway System roadsides are attractive.
