

WHY IT'S IMPORTANT



Pavement Conditions




The State Highway System has remained at or near the target of 80% non-deficient throughout the past decade.



Bridge Conditions




Over 95% of all FDOT maintained bridges meet standards (bridges not showing evidence of structural deterioration and not weight restricted).



Roadway Maintenance



FDOT is committed to achieving all maintenance standards for the State Highway System (potholes, signs, lighting, mowing, litter removal, etc.).



Transit State of Good Repair



Florida transit agencies have kept vehicle breakdowns at a level better than one per 4,000 miles—fewer breakdowns means better transit performance.
