HPMS

- Data items reported by states each year for roadway segments
 - Traffic counts
 - Pavement type
 - Percent trucks
 - Pavement condition and roughness
 - Used in biennial report to Congress on the Status of Nations Highways and Bridges
 - Used in apportionment of funds

NBIS

- National Bridge Inventory System
- Data submittal by the States
- Inventory of Structures
- Condition
- Rating
- Used in the Report to Congress on the Status of the Nations Highways and Bridges
- Eligibility for Funding

Highway Statistics

- FHWA 500 Series Reports
 - Motor fuel
 - Licensed drivers
 - Registered vehicles
 - Funds expended
 - Used in Hwy Statistics Publication
 - Track Trends

NHTS

- National HHOLD Travel Survey
- Data collection of 151,000 households (325,000 persons)
- Completed in May 2009
- Will be released in January 2010 in conjunction with TRB
- Data and characteristics of HHOLD travel
- FHWA thanks AASHTO for their support on the 2008 NHTS

CTPP

- FHWA, FTA, and AASHTO have been working closely together on the CTPP using the ACS
- NCHRP 08-79 project – “Transportation Data Products from ACS that Comply with Census Bureau Disclosure Rules”
- For 2010 ACS replaces the CTPP
- ACS is a continuous survey
- ACS provides timely demographic, housing, and economic information
- First CTPP using ACS results are expected to be available in Spring or Summer 2010 using 3 years of ACS (2006-2008).

ARRA of 2009

- Requires detailed reporting by States on ARRA funded projects:
 - Jobs created and retained
 - Amount of funds obligated
 - Status of Projects
 - Amount of funds expended
 - Project details

Reauthorization

- Performance Based Planning
- Data Implications
 - Safety
 - Pavements & Bridges
 - Mobility/Congestion
 - Green House Gases (GHG)
 - Environment
 - Livability
