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### **The New Work Types in Groups 4, 9, and 10 Will Not Be Implemented Until August 1, 2006**

Rule 14-75 has been substantially revised, creating sixteen new work types within FDOT Work Groups 4, 9, and 10.

In prior communications, you were notified that the new Work Types would be rolled out for FDOT advertisements beginning July 1, 2006. The implementation date has been delayed by one month until August 1, 2006, due to the scant numbers of firms that have applied and been approved for qualification in the new work types. There will be no extensions beyond August 1<sup>st</sup>.

As of **6/12/2006**, the numbers of consultant firms qualified in the new Work Types are:

4.1.1	Miscellaneous Structures	3 firms qualified
4.1.2	Minor Bridge Design.	1 firm qualified
4.2.1	Major Bridge Design- Concrete	0 firms qualified
4.2.2	Major Bridge Design- Steel	0 firms qualified
4.2.3	Major Bridge Design- Segmental	0 firms qualified
4.3.1	Complex Bridge Design- Concrete	0 firms qualified
4.3.2	Complex Bridge Design- Steel	0 firms qualified
9.4.1	Standard Foundation Studies	14 firms qualified
9.4.2	Non-Redundant Drilled Shaft Bridge Foundation Studies	2 firms qualified
10.4	Minor Bridge & Miscellaneous Structures CEI	7 firms qualified
10.5.1	Major Bridge CEI- Concrete	2 firms qualified
10.5.2	Major Bridge CEI- Steel	2 firms qualified
10.5.3	Major Bridge CEI- Segmental	1 firm qualified
10.6.1	Complex Bridge CEI- Concrete	0 firms qualified
10.6.2	Complex Bridge CEI- Steel	0 firms qualified
10.7	Movable Span Bridge CEI	0 firms qualified

Even if you previously qualified for related Work Types under Groups 4, 9, and 10, you will still need to submit anew for qualification in any of the sixteen work types identified above. **NO FIRMS WILL BE GRANDFATHERED INTO THE NEW WORK TYPES.**

Also effective August 1, 2006, the following work types will NO LONGER be used for new professional services advertisements:

- 4.1 Minor Bridge Design
- 4.2 Major Bridge Design
- 4.3 Complex Bridge Design
- 9.4 Foundation Studies
- 10.2 Major Bridge Construction Engineering Inspection
