SUBJECT: Wet Weather Pavement Markings

ISSUE BACKGROUND: Developmental Specification 702 has been limited to products which could meet the specification. During the developmental process multiple products have been installed which meet the requirements of the developmental specification. The specification has been revised as a supplemental specification, to be implemented effective with the August 2010 letting. This will allow the Department to begin the QPL process of approving and evaluating wet weather products, and streamlining the acceptance of the products in the field. Guidance for the usage of Wet Weather Pavement Markings will be provided in the Plans Preparation Manual (PPM) and the Basis of Estimates (BOE).

IMPLEMENTATION: A mandatory specification revision has been issued, effective with the August 2010 letting.

Update Pay Items: The following pay items will be valid through July 31, 2010:
906-702- AA Wet Weather Pavement Markings

The following pay items are valid for projects let August 1, 2010 and later:

702- 1A-BCD Wet Weather Pavement Markings

D= Width
