

Accessing LRE

LRE is an access-controlled internet application, requiring an FDOT RACF/mainframe user ID and designated access to the LRE system. Consultants needing LRE access should contact their FDOT Project Manager for direction, and should make plans to attend the LRE Users training.

LRE Project Levels

Project:

Contains project identification information (Project number, District, County, Letting Date, etc.)

Pulls data from Financial Management system

Version:

Allows several versions of the same project (for alternate designs)

Project totals are at the Version level

There is always a designated Primary version

Sequence:

Relates to typical section(s) on the project

User specified length for each sequence

12 typical section models available, representing construction type, median and shoulder type

Default measurements & pay items describe assumed characteristics; these can be changed, as necessary.

Component:

Relates to a design group of work on the project, or a pay item group (Earthwork, Roadway, Drainage, Signing, Signalization, Bridges, etc.)

Components are either required or optional, based on the model selected

Note that when the project is first created, the first version, and the first sequence are also created.

Reports

Some of the commonly used reports are listed below. For a complete list of reports, refer to the Reports Tab within the LRE application

R4*: Project Details Composite, by version Summary of pay items and quantities, in numeric order by pay item. Like items that appear on multiple sequences or components are “rolled-up” for a total quantity.

R4: Project Details Composite, by component Similar to R4, but itemized by each component.

R7: LRE vs WPA Report A quick look at LRE vs current WPA totals. NOTE: Current year projects may have moved to TRNS*PORT, and may not be current in LRE.

District Summary Report Listing of current projects within the District file, sorted by FPID number, and displaying the Project Description, Project Manager, Letting FY, and Project Total. Displays primary versions of official projects only.
