Re: Streamline Lump Sum Contracts

ISSUE / REQUIREMENT: A contract that is less than \$2 million dollars and has less than 2,000 tons of asphalt can be let using the streamline specification. Streamline contracts can be either plan quantity (all items are paid as plan quantity) or lump sum. A streamline lump sum contract is just like a conventional lump sum contract except it meets the requirements above.

In Trns•port, contract type CSL has been set-up for streamline contracts. **A lump sum contract that includes the streamline specification shall use contract type CSL. All lump sum contract without the streamline specification shall use contract type CLS.**
