Comments:

I recommend including the requirement that the contractor restripe if the durable pavement markings fall below 150 during the 18 month service life. This addresses failure of the durable pavement markings and keeps the paint spec consistent. See attachment for my suggested language.

~~Response: The last paragraph of Section 710-4.3 will be revised to read as follows. "For work zone markings, ensure the minimum retroreflectance of the white and yellow pavement markings are not less than 150 med/lx-m<sup>2</sup>. If the retroreflectivity values fall below 150 med/lx-m<sup>2</sup> within six months of initial application for standard paint, the striping will be reapplied at the Contractor's expense. If the retroreflectivity values fall below 150 med/lx-m<sup>2</sup> within eighteen months of initial application for durable paint, the striping will be reapplied at the Contractor's expense".~~

We concur with your comment. Work zone comment will be deleted. (7-29-09)

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Due to QPL issues, the durable paint will not be implemented in January 2010. All references to durable paint have been removed. (From the Specifications office, 7-29-09)
