I have reviewed the above referenced Industry Review Specifications and have the following comment: The term “LED” should be defined in the applicable Specification of which it is contained. I have no other comments at this time.

Response:

The term “LEDs” is defined to be an abbreviation for “light emitting diodes” upon its first use in the section (784-1.2.7)

Change: “EIA/TIA-232 and TIA 422” to “EIA/TIA-232 or TIA 422.” Explanation: EIA/TIA-232 & TIA-422 are mutually exclusive, each District selects one or the other for their video encoders/decoders.

Response:

The intent of the statement is to require that the serial interface on these devices be programmable by the user and not limited by the hardware, for instance the ability to select either 232 or 422 during device configuration would satisfy the requirement. We believe that the existing text is sufficient at this time to ensure that devices evaluated, approved, and placed on the APL have this required capability.
