COMMENTS FROM INTERNAL/INDUSTRY REVIEW

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Comments: (8-2-12)

1. 8.1.5.2.3 is not consistent with what's written in 8.2. In 8.2.6.4, it states that the quality control plan is in compliance with Materials Manual 5.6. In 8.2.6.1, it states that the quality control plan is in accordance with Specifications Section 105 and the Materials Manual 5.6 may be used as a guideline. This should be made consistent.

**Response: No change made. This Section does not follow the same format as the Volume II documents. In future changes to 8.1 this will be addressed.**

2. 8.1.5.2.3 should state that an in-depth inspection is also required for Plants to be placed back on Active Status. Some Plants which need an in-depth inspection have produced for the Department within the last year. Routine inspections and Plant qualification reviews need to be done until the Plants have been placed on Status B, inactive. If we only do these inspections on Plants which furnish Structures for Department projects, we will run into problems if they get a job and we haven't kept up with our inspections.

**Response: No change made at this time. The comment will be discussed by State Materials Office with District Materials Offices.**

3. Change "Plant's" to "Plant's" in 8.1.5.2.3.

**Response: Change made.**

4. Change "prestrssed" to "prestressed" in 8.1.5.3.2.1 (15).

**Response: Change made.**

5. I'm not sure why DISTRICT was removed from the title of 8.1.7. The Project Administrator's role does fall under District Construction Offices Responsibilities.

**Response: The Project Administrator does not work directly for the District Construction Office and no other duties related to the District Construction's role.**

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
