SUBARTICLE 337-2.2 is deleted and the following substituted:

337-2.2 Asphalt Binder: Meet the requirements of Section 916, and any additional requirements or modifications specified herein for the various mixtures. ~~For projects with a total quantity of FC 5, FC 9.5, or FC 12.5 less than 500 tons, the Contractor may elect to substitute a PG 76 22 (PMA) or PG 82 22 (PMA) for the PG 76 22 (ARB), meeting the requirements of Section 916. Obtain asphalt rubber binder from a plant that is currently on the Department's Production Facility Listing. Producers seeking inclusion on the list shall meet the requirements of Section 916.~~
