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

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

	<p>Florida Advanced Certification does not currently require any JOBSITE work experience. Therefore to have a Florida Advanced Certified Supervisor initiate, install and maintain traffic control devices may leave you with a person with little of NO actual on road experience responsible for a project.</p> <p>Currently many office personnel and FDOT employees with ZERO job site experience have been certified just by taking a 2 1/2 day course and passing a written test. In the past to become a Work Site Traffic Supervisor ATSSA has required a minimum of 2 years of jobsite experience and references. There should definitely be a distinction between the current Florida advanced certification and the past certification of Worksite Traffic Supervisor that differentiates between someone that can sit in an office and design a plan compared with someone that can supervise the setup of a lane closure or traffic switch on the road! Accordingly this distinction must be addressed and recognized by FDOT to exist. ATSSA does! Thank you for your understanding of this important comment.</p>	<p>No Change: Procedure 625-010-010 Section 6.6 requires a prerequisite for advanced training as follows: One year experience in work zone traffic control or responsible for work zone traffic control plan development.</p> <p>Providers of Advanced Maintenance of Traffic Training have been required to document how they determine each student meets the prerequisite when they submit the course for review. If a person attends and passes the Advanced training without meeting the prerequisite, they might have to address this in court if there is a crash on a project that they acted as the WTS.</p> <p>A company may request to review the WTS experience and qualifications as well as verify that the WTS possesses a current valid certificate prior to assigning that person as their WTS. If a person has years of traffic control plans design and no field experience, they should be trained in the field prior to being given the responsibility of setting up a work zone in the field. This is a business decision made by each company.</p>	Steve Keller	Adams

Procedure 625-010-010 Section 6.7.1 states: The instructor may use training videos, handouts, or other methods to ensure that the flagger has demonstrated knowledge and proficiency in flagging operations. No formal submittal of this course to the MOTC for review is required. 



The Contractor's Worksite Traffic Supervisor must be trained in the Advanced category, therefore they can train flaggers as long as they document the training.

Persons that attend Intermediate or Advanced Training are taught about flagging and told that as long as they hold a current valid certificate, they are authorized to train flaggers in accordance with the Procedure (See Below).

I will talk with Const and Specs to see if they think we need to clarify the proposed language to address your concerns.

Thanks

From the Maintenance of Traffic Training Procedure:

6.7.1 Basic Training - The minimum basic training areas to be covered shall be Part 6 of the MUTCD Section 6E (Flagger Control), and Design Standards Index 600 (Flagging Operations and Night Time Flagging) and (General Information for Traffic Control Through Work Zones). The field demonstration shall be a dexterity test using hand-signaling devices (STOP/SLOW paddle and flag) during flagging type operations and placement of traffic control devices. In order to successfully complete Basic Training, the instructor shall determine that the flagger has demonstrated knowledge and proficiency in flagging operations. A person who has successfully completed the Intermediate, Intermediate Refresher, Advanced, or Advanced Refresher Course and holds a current valid and verifiable, wallet card may provide training for flaggers. The instructor may use training videos, handouts, or other methods to ensure that the flagger has demonstrated knowledge and proficiency in flagging operations. No formal submittal of this course to the MOTC for review is required. No time requirement is set for the training, but the instructor will be required to keep a record of persons they have successfully trained and the date they were trained.

Cheryl,

What does it mean when you say "ensure the flagger holds a Maintenance of Traffic Training Basic qualification"? If this means a training course that cannot be taught on-site by the work site traffic supervisor we would have serious concerns about the specification. Contractors need the flexibility to train flaggers on site and relatively quickly. In it obviously in the contractor's best interest to have trained flaggers. It is often not practical to provide time to send a flagger to "school" away from the job. Many times a flagger does not remain very long with a contractor.
