INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS–VIDEO EQUIPMENT.

SUBARTICLE 782-3.1 (of the Supplemental Specifications) is deleted and the following substituted:

782-3.1 General: Ensure that CCTV cameras and video display equipment furnished, assembled, or installed have a manufacturer’s warranty covering defects in assembly, fabrication, and materials for a minimum of three years from the date of final acceptance by the Engineer in accordance with 5-11 of all work to be performed under the Contract. If the manufacturer’s warranties for the components are for a longer period, those longer period warranties will apply.

~~Replace any CCTV camera part or equipment found to be defective during the warranty period at no cost to the Department within 10 calendar days of notification by the Engineer.~~

Ensure that the manufacturer’s warranties on CCTV cameras and video display equipment are fully transferable from the Contractor to the Department. *Ensure that these warranties require the manufacturer to furnish replacements for any part or equipment found to be defective during the warranty period at no cost to the Department within 10 calendar days of notification by the Department.*

Because the video wall display system is a mission-critical part of the TMC, the warranty and maintenance period shall apply to the entire system and its associated subsystems, and shall include the following tasks:

1. Replace any operational support supplies used during this warranty period at no additional cost to the Department, including the operational support supplies used for repairs made due to lightning damage.
2. Conduct regularly scheduled preventive maintenance every six months for the initial one-year period.
3. For service and repairs during and beyond the warranty period, designate either the video wall display system Contractor, the equipment dealer, or the manufacturer’s field technician as the representative responsible for providing this ongoing support to the TMC.
4. Allow no more than 24 hours to elapse between the time of the Department’s notification that a repair is needed and the time repair commences.
