METAL ACCESSORY MATERIALS FOR CONCRETE PAVEMENT AND CONCRETE STRUCTURES.

(REV 9-1819-13)

SUBARTICLE 931-3.6 is deleted and the following substituted:

931-3.6 Materials: The wire for the welded assembly shall be in accordance with all applicable requirements of ASTM A82.

After fabrication, Aapply one coat of alkyd primer meeting the material requirements of SSPC Paint 25 to all exposed surfaces of the assembly. Apply the primer in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations.

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
