Table 334-8 Specification Limits (red text) includes limits for Course Graded mix. Unless I missed something, Course Graded Mix is no longer allowed in Florida. It looks like the older version of the Specification Limits Table (334-7) that is in blue text but struck out in this copy actually has the correct information.

Response: The reviewer is correct. References to coarse graded mixtures will be removed.

Mark found a sentence in the 334 Spec that I believe has some redundant wording that could be cleaned up in the next revision:

**334-2.3.5 : ...**”The Engineer reserves the right to change the asphalt binder **type and** grade at design based on the characteristics of the RAP asphalt binder, and reserves the right to make changes during production.”

I am figuring that the “type and grade” wording was probably there for when we had the three binder types (ARB, RA, PG).

Response: This suggested change will be passed on to the Specifications Office to revise as RA types are no longer part of the Specification.  
From the Specifications Office: This change will be included in a future revision of Section 334.
