1. 684-3.2.15 Environmental Specifications: Recommend revising the temperature range back to 113 degrees as originally stated in this specification instead of lowering it to 104 degrees. From previous experience, readings of 110 degrees are common in the Florida climate, so 104 may be easily exceeded. (Kandarappallil Jose)
