## LEGAL REQUIREMENTS AND RESPONSIBILITY TO THE PUBLIC – DUST CONTROL.

(REV <del>12-22-15</del><u>1-15-152-1-16</u>)

SUBARTICLE 7-20.2 is deleted and the following substituted:

7-20.2 Dust Control: Ensure that excessive dust is not transported beyond the limits of construction in populated areas. The Contractor may control dust for embankments or other cleared or unsurfaced areas by applying water or calcium chloride, as directed by the Engineer. Use calcium chloride in accordance with 102–5. When included in the Plans, install mulch, seed, sod, or temporary paving as early as practical in the project. Control dust during the storage and handling of dusty materials by wetting, covering, or other means as approved by the Engineer. When included in the Plans, install mulch, seed, sod, or temporary paving early in the project.

SUBARTICLE 7-20.2 is deleted and the following substituted:

**7-20.2 Dust Control:** Control dust during the storage and handling of dusty materials by wetting, covering, or other means as approved by the Engineer.
