347-2.1 General: Certify that all materials used in concrete are from Department approved sources, and free from frozen or other detrimental matter.

Meet the following requirements:

Portland Cement.....Section 921

Coarse Aggregate*.....Section 901

Fine Aggregate*.....Section 902

Water.....Section 923

Chemical AdmixturesSection 924

Pozzolans and SlagSection 929

*Recycled Asphalt Pavement (RAP) may replace up to 20% of the total aggregate in the design mix. Certify to the Engineer the RAP meets the gradation requirements in Sections 901 and 902 Use RAP from a Department approved stockpile.
