These changes require special implementation because of the increased use of audible vibratory and wet weather pavement markings and to allow the use of the latest product developments.

An implementation of August lettings was chosen to allow incorporation into projects without revisions.

If the specification package has been compiled, incorporate these revisions as described in the remarks column. If the specification package has not been compiled, follow normal procedures. Hopefully, this will lessen the impact by not requiring changes to jobs that do not have 701 or 702 items. Let me know if there are any questions.
