**CONTRACTOR QUALITY CONTROL GENERAL REQUIREMENTS.
(REV 8-31-15)**

SUBARTICLE 105-8.10.2.4.2 is deleted and the following substituted:

105-8.10.2.4.2: Batch Plant Operator: Ensure the concrete batch plant operator is qualified as a CTQP Concrete Batch Plant Operator. As an alternative to CTQP qualification, the Department will accept the completion of a minimum of a six hour, Department approved, Batch Plant Operator training course. For dry cast concrete pipe and dry cast drainage structures, as an alternative to CTQP qualification, the Department will accept the American Concrete Pipe Association (ACPA) Quality School Level II Certification.
