

What other local aid programs exist in addition to the LAP Program?

Purpose: To describe other FDOT local aid programs and the applicable types of projects and necessary parameters for funding a project out of one of these state funded programs.

Details: In addition to the LAP Program, which is funded with federal funds, the following state funded local aid programs exist:

County Incentive Grant Program (CIGP): Under the CIGP program, grants are provided to counties to fund improvements to transportation facilities, including transit, which are located on the State Highway System, or which relieve traffic congestion on the State Highway System, per Section 339.2817, Florida Statutes.

Small County Outreach Program (SCOP): The SCOP program is available to assist small county governments in repairing or rehabilitating county bridges, paving unpaved roads, addressing road-related drainage improvements, resurfacing or reconstructing county roads, or constructing capacity or safety improvements on county roads.

Small County Road Assistance Program (SCRAP): The purpose of the SCRAP program is to assist small county governments in resurfacing and reconstructing county roads. Beginning in FY 2000 until FY 2010, and beginning again with FY 2013, up to \$25 million annually is available to be allocated for the purposes of funding this program.

Transportation Regional Incentive Program (TRIP): The TRIP program provides funding to improve regionally significant transportation facilities in "regional transportation areas." State funds are available throughout Florida to provide incentives for local governments and the private sector to help pay for critically needed projects that benefit regional travel and commerce.
