

Where may I obtain electronic versions of FDOT specifications for use on local agency projects?

Purpose: To provide a brief overview of the new file server capabilities found within the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) *Specs on the Web* application. The updates to this application were developed to aid in the creation of specification packages for local agency projects.

Details: [Specs on the Web](#) is the application used by the Department to prepare specification packages for FDOT let contracts. The *Specs on the Web* application has been enhanced to include a new option which enables local agencies to access and download specifications for use on local agency projects.

This new feature allows users the option to select "[Local Agency Specs](#)" from the home page menu without logging into the application. This access then provides the specifications in MS Word format to be selected for download and incorporation into the specifications document being prepared for the local agency project.

This "file server" option enables the user to prepare and assemble a package using a combination of the FDOT approved off-system project Local Agency Program (LAP) Big 4 Specifications and FDOT Standard Specifications including implemented revisions to the standard specifications and FDOT archived specifications.

After the applicable specifications have been selected (checked), select the "Merge Specifications" option and all selected specifications will be merged into a single word file which includes an automated table of contents. The merged document will NOT be saved to the applications server, but may be saved to the user's local computer or network.

The user may also register for an account in *Specs on the Web* to be able to create a specifications package to be saved in the application's server. Project specific information is required when logged in and navigating the application to create a specifications package. Please [contact](#) the Department for further assistance, if needed, with logging in and using the full capabilities of the application for the preparation of the specifications documents for local agency use.
