

The below language is an amendment to the Draft 2016 UAM revised June 16, 2016. This was posted June 28, 2016 for discussion at the July 11, 2016 Rule Workshop.

2.1 General UAO Responsibilities...

5) The UAO shall notify the FDOT Representative identified on the permit a minimum of two (2) business days prior to starting work and again immediately upon completion of work. All work, materials, and equipment shall be subject to inspection and approval by FDOT. The UAO shall input time, location of lane closure and description of work into the FDOT Lane Closure Information System (LCIS) of any lane closures needed for the utility work. The UAO shall not close any lanes until receiving approval through LCIS. The UAO is not required to report lane closures to the LCIS system to perform work in accordance to *UAM Section 2.3* or *UAM Section 3.1*.
