RESOLUTION NO. 94-52

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CERTAIN PINELLAS COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS, UTILITIES, AND PARKS DEPARTMENTS PERSONNEL, AS DESIGNATED BY THE PINELLAS COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, TO SIGN FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PERMIT APPLICATIONS

WHEREAS, Chapter 338 of the Florida Statutes provides that a permit granting permission from the State of Florida Department of Transportation be issued to construct a project in a Florida State Road; and

WHEREAS, this permit must be applied for by any person or persons commencing construction in a Florida State Road and is of benefit to all such persons, including the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners, as all applicants must conform to the Florida Department of Transportation Utility Accommodation Guide; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation is the responsible regulatory agency for Chapter 338, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Pinellas County Departments of Public Works, Utilities and Parks are responsible for the investigation, preparation, and supervision of the work involved in these permits, and authorization for them to sign these applications will simplify administrative procedures in obtaining the necessary Florida Department of Transportation approval and will allow waiver of the County seal as required by the Florida Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida, in regular session duly assembled this 15th day of February, 1994;

THAT, the Pinellas County Administrator is hereby authorized to designate persons employed by the above County Departments to sign applications for Florida Department of Transportation Permits.
