**SUBJECT: REVISIONS TO SPECIFICATION SECTION 102 – MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC**

The July 2017 Specification Workbook will contain the following subsection that has been revised (revisions highlighted) to clarify the requirements of the contractor to confirm/update Lane Closure Information System (LCIS) submittals biweekly. Clarification was also added to define routine lane closures, mobile operations, and traffic pacing operations as being planned operations.

**102-3.3 Lane Closure Information System:** Approval for all lane closures, mobile operations, and traffic pacing operations is required. Submit routine requests fourteen calendar days in advance of **all planned** lane closures, mobile operations, and traffic pacing operations at the following URL address: <https://lcis.dot.state.fl.us/>. **Confirm at least once every two weeks that information entered within LCIS reflects current planned operations and update as necessary.** For unforeseen events that require cancelling or rescheduling lane closures, mobile operations, and traffic pacing operations, revise the lane closure request as soon as possible.

Modify contracts let from July 2016 to June 2017 by removing existing 102-3.3 subsection and replace with version shown above. **This memorandum serves as a blanket approval to process a \$0.00 contract change and should be attached to the Work Order or Supplemental Agreement.**
