Authority for Self-Assessment

Section	Requirement
FDOT Topic 001-260-001	Quality Assurance and Quality Control Policy requiring OEM to conduct an annual Quality Assurance Review.
Section 8.2.5: MOU	FDOT shall perform annual self-assessments of its QA/QC process and performance to determine if its process is working as intended.
Section 8.2.6: MOU	Upon the Effective Date of this MOU, FDOT will maintain a list of NEPA approvals and decisions it makes under this MOU. FDOT will provide this list to FHWA on a quarterly basis
Section 10.1.3: MOU	FDOT shall collect and maintain necessary and appropriate data related to the performance measures FDOT shall monitor its progress toward meeting the performance measures and include its progress in the self-assessment







Purpose of Self-Assessment and Review Team Members

- Purpose is to annually assess FDOT performance and compliance with the MOU, NEPA, and environmental laws and regulations

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

Project Approvals Report

- FHWA requires FDOT provide a quarterly list of certified Approvals and Decisions for NEPA projects
- The list includes; Type 1 CEs, Type 2 CEs, EAs, FONSIs, DEISs, FEISs, FEIS/RODs, RODs, Section 4(f) Determinations, and Re-evaluations







2017 Focus Topics

- Documentation and tracking of commitments
- Type 1 CE /Districts providing supporting documentation
- Ponds are considered in PD&E and Reevaluation
- Species consultation documented
- Documentation of District QA/QC







2017 Self-Assessment Outcomes

- For qualifying projects, performance results showed FDOT meeting or exceeding performance targets for 8 of the nine metrics; and within 10% below the target for the 9th metric
- Found 3 successful practices on documenting files beyond requirements
- Found 12 opportunities for improvement on improperly documenting commitments and other aspects of documentation in the project files
- Found 3 non-compliance observations on permitting and commitments – which were resolved by the District on or before September 29, 2017 – no outstanding actions





Self-Assessment Scope



- Review period of May 1, 2017 through April 30, 2018, selected to be consistent with FHWA audit period
- All NEPA Performance Measures with qualifying projects (Compliance with NEPA and federal environmental laws, QA/QC of NEPA Decisions, Relationships with Agencies and the Public, and Increased Efficiency and Timeliness of NEPA Process)
- Sample of Project Approvals to review based upon NEPA focus topics (may not be the same projects as FHWA Audit)





2018 Focus Topics for Desk Review

NEPA Assignment Self-Assessment Project-Related Review Topics			
No.	TOPICS	Level of Review	
1	Noise	Review previous Noise QAR. Come up with relevant questions / requirements, i.e., cost feasibility considered, noise walls identified	
2	Type 1 Categorical Exclusions	Review to ensure adequate documentation related to 106 or 4(f), Species, Contamination, Relocation	
3	Re- evaluations	Review to ensure adequate documentation related to 106 or 4(f), Species, Contamination, Relocation	
4	MOU Standard Statement	Review Cultural Resource Assessment Survey, Preliminary Engineering Report, Natural Resources Evaluation, and Public Involvement notices to ensure required MOU language is present; for technical documents finalized after NEPA Assignment	







Overview of Self-Assessment Process

- Identification of NEPA focus topics, review criteria, and sample of NEPA project approvals
- OEM team will conduct desk review of project documentation and contact District staff as needed for feedback
- OEM will prepare a report of successful practices, findings and observations, if any
- Two-week District review period for draft report
- OEM will provide final report to Districts and a summary to FHWA






Next Steps

- Review Team will conduct desk review from May 1st through June 29th and Districts may be contacted during this period

2017 FHWA's Draft Audit Outcomes

- FHWA cited 13 successful practices, including good relationships with our agencies; QA/QC; SWEPT and ERC; engaged legal staff; and training opportunities
- FHWA cited 3 observations covering Commitments, program level coordination, and QA/QC
- FHWA cited 1 non-compliance observation that project files contained insufficient documentation
- OEM responded to observations, and that noncompliance would be appropriately addressed
- As of April 30, 2018, the FHWA audit report had not been finalized; currently posted in Federal Register for public comment until May 18, 2018







FHWA Audit Readiness for 2018

- FHWA Auditors will visit Districts **3, 4, 6** and **Central**Office September **24**th and **25**th
- Auditors begin reviewing FDOT NEPA project files on May 7th
- Last year, FHWA identified incomplete project documentation concerns; now is time for Districts to double check documentation in SWEPT
- Before September 24th visit, Districts should make sure all new management, staff and consultants have completed NEPA Assignment training in Learning Curve or at OEM website; refreshers as needed
- OEM will be reaching out to Districts and communicating important details relating to FHWA Audit as September approaches


