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County Road 97A Boggy Creek Bridge Replacement Project

Chipley, FL – Construction activities will begin the week of January 1 on County Road 97A over Boggy Creek Northwest of Cantonment in Escambia County. The existing bridge will be replaced with a new, modern structure with 12-foot travel lanes, eight foot shoulders and a solid concrete barrier railing. The bridge approaches will also be replaced.

Crews will begin clearing trees and shrubs to build a temporary detour (acrow) bridge. Once completed, traffic will be shifted to the acrow bridge as crews construct the new structure. Work is anticipated to be complete in eight months, weather permitting.

Drivers are reminded to slow down to the posted speed limit of 30 MPH, use caution and be aware of the 'S' shaped curve when approached the temporary bridge. There will be weight restriction on the temporary detour bridge. Vehicles weighing over 88,000 ponds and cranes will be prohibited.
