## FDOT to Host U.S. 90 Alternatives Action Plan Meeting

Chipley – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an alternatives public meeting concerning the State Road (S.R.) 10 (U.S. 90) Action Plan in Leon County. The meeting will be held Tuesday, Jan. 24, 2017 from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. EDT at the Leroy Collins Leon County Public Library, Rooms A and B, 200 West Park Avenue, Tallahassee. The purpose of the meeting is to present existing and future conditions on the study corridor and present potential alternatives to accommodate future needs.

The intent of this study is to document viable alternatives, evaluate the stormwater management needs; as well as, to assess social-economic and environmental impacts for each alternative. There will be a video presentation, maps, drawings and other study information on display. In addition, FDOT representatives will be available to answer questions.
